



## Instructions for returning to church

When coming to church the following instructions will help you and others to stay safe.

- The maximum number permitted in the main church room will be limited to 35.
- You will be asked to wear a mask at all times and to sanitise your hands when entering the building.
- The seats will need to be socially distanced and you will be asked not to move them and to remain in your seat at all times (unless you need to use the toilets).
- There will be a one-way system into and out of the building and around the church room.
- We will need contact details of those attending the service so that we can contact you should someone else attending subsequently test positive.
- Singing is not allowed at present and the hymn books will not be in use.
- There will be no shared/provided refreshments after worship. Please feel free to bring your own if you wish to have a drink during worship as the kitchen will not be accessible.
- There will be no socialising before or after the service in the foyer. By remaining in your seat, you can chat to the people nearest you before and after the service for a few minutes.
- Maintain social distancing at all times when entering and leaving the building. Don't stand by the entrances waiting for others before and after the service.
- Do not touch surfaces unnecessarily whilst moving around the building.
- Obey all signage that will be displayed in and around the building at all times.
- The number of people allowed in the toilets at any one time will be limited.
- You cannot ask for a lift from other members.

Finally, please listen and follow instructions given by the stewards at all times. They are there to protect you and keep everyone safe. Please respect social distancing within the building and when waiting outside to be admitted.
