Happy New Year to you!

Aston & Nechells Foodbank wish to thank everyone for the wonderful generosity received in the run up to Christmas, over 4 tonnes of long-life food was received in less than 6 weeks.

However, on Friday 6th January at just one distribution session in Aston we redeemed 60 vouchers helping 110 people in crisis. The increase in numbers is still continuing.

Already we are running short of all toiletry items and tinned fruit, rice puddings, UHT milk and long-life fruit juice.

In addition, with seeing ever increasing numbers coming on Wednesdays and Fridays, we need more volunteers able to help on a regular weekly or fortnightly basis.

Can you help by organising a toiletries collection, or by adopting specific collections for one or more of the food items outlined above?
